Health

- Two new high-tech operating rooms at the Royal Brisbane Hospital
- \$1.2m for local mental health services
- Funding for 1,000 new nurse training positions every year
- Double the training places for GPs

Older Australians

- Increased pensions by around \$100 per fortnight for singles and \$74 for couples
- Protected tax free status for superannuation income
- Extended the Seniors Supplement payment to 300,000 self-funded retirees

Jobs & the Economy

- Personal taxes cut in all three Labor budgets
- OECD says decisive Labor action saved 250,000 jobs
- Ensured Australia is the only advanced economy to avoid recession

Small Business

- Lowering company tax to 29% in 2012
